Mediators Code of Ethics

- **Uphold and abide by the Rules of Conduct, Regulations and other Professional requirements adopted by the Association.**
- **Not to carry on any activity or conduct which could reasonably be considered as conduct unbecoming of a member of the Association.**
- **Uphold the integrity and fairness of the mediation process.**
- **Ensure that the parties involved in a mediation process are fairly informed and have an adequate understanding of the procedural aspects of the process and of their obligations to pay for services rendered.**
- **Shall satisfy her/himself that (s)he is qualified to undertake and complete an appointment in a professional manner.**
- **Disclose any interest or relationship likely to affect impartiality or which might create an appearance of partiality or bias.**
- **In communicating with the parties, avoid impropriety or the appearance of impropriety.**
- **Conduct all proceedings fairly and diligently, exhibiting independence and impartiality.**
- **Be faithful to the relationship of trust and confidentiality inherent in the office of mediator.**
- **Conduct all proceedings related to resolution of a dispute in accordance with applicable Law.**
